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| BI 107.3 OT 507.3 | Genesis 12 - Deuteronomy A study of the Mosaic record of God's development of the nation of Israel from the call of Abraham in Genesis 12 to the death of Moses at the end of Deuteronomy. |
| BI 205.3 NT 514.3 | Acts An analysis and exposition of Acts, covering the works of the Holy Spirit through the lives of the Apostles and the founding of the NT church. |
| BL 201.3 BL 509.3 | Elementary Greek I A study of the basic forms and principles of Biblical Greek, including instruction on the proper use of language study tools for accurate interpretation and application. |
| BL 301.3 BL 511.3 | Greek Exegesis I A progressing study of Biblical Greek developing upon the basics of Elementary Greek especially in a context of actual exegesis of Scripture texts. Prerequisites: Elementary Greek I and II. |
| BL 408.3 BL 501.3 | Elementary Hebrew I A study of the basic forms and principles of Biblical Hebrew, including word formation, vocabulary, basic grammar, and instruction on the proper use of language study tools for accurate interpretation and application. |
| BC 102.3 BC 510.3 | Principles for Christian Living A study of the discipleship principles necessary to develop and maintain a mature Christian philosophy covering every aspect of life. |
| BC 228.3 BC 528.3 | Parenting A basic study of Biblical parenting. An emphasis will be placed on the proper place and use of authority/leadership within the home in the arena of child-rearing, single-parenting, working mothers, grand-parenting. |
| BC 208.2 BC 608.2 BC 209.2 BC 609.2 | Women Ministering to Women I and II A study, consisting of two successive courses, covering Biblical principles for women ministering to women. Topics include helping women in problem marriages, single teen mothers, and women considering adoption. |
| BC 308.3 BC 508.3 | Crisis Counseling A study of Biblical methods and solutions for counseling in crisis situations, including suicide, immorality, addictions, severe depression, fear, rebellion, worry, and other life-domination sins. |
| EN 102.3 | English Grammar and Composition A continuation of EN 101 with further development of the proper application of English grammar. |
| PS 420.3 PS 540.3 | Pastoral Theology & Practice A foundational study of God's design for the thinking and actions of those who serve as pastors, evangelists, missionaries, teachers, and all other roles prominent in assemblies of believers, beginning with an analysis of related Scriptures and moving to application of this Biblical foundation to all aspects of interpersonal relationships, ministry responsibilities, and management of assembly activities. |
| BI 441.3 TH 715.3 | Biblical Theology OT / OT Theology An analytical study designed to develop an accurate understanding of the unchanging person and nature of God from the very earliest words of His revelation, demonstrating and demanding consistent application of His nature as Creator, Owner, Designer, and Absolute Authority from eternity past to eternity future in every aspect of the creation. |
