The Titus Fund: A Description

The Titus Fund is a ministry of Tabernacle Baptist Bible College and Seminary designed to help international students who desire to come to the United States to formally study God's Word in a college and seminary environment. After finishing their training, they take the Gospel back to their native land, evangelize their own people, and educate them with the truths they learned at Tabernacle.

Who can receive the Titus Fund?

Tabernacle Baptist Bible College and Seminary realizes that discretion must be involved when supporting a foreign student with the Titus Fund. Therefore, TBBCS has put the following guidelines in place.

- The student must be a saved, baptized member in good standing in a local church of his homeland.
- The student must be carefully selected and recommended by a missionary or pastor of like faith.
- The area in which the student resides must be in need of sound, theological education.
- The student must realize that he is only permitted at TBBCS to receive training, then he is expected to return to his native land to educate his own people in sound, Biblical doctrine.

Why is the Titus Fund necessary?

Because of US immigration policy, a foreign student is limited in the number of hours he may work and the type of job he may have. Because of this, the foreign student needs financial support to complete his training. Yearly fees for a full-time student cost about \$ 5,500.

Does this program work?

Yes. Here are several testimonies of people who have benefited from the Titus Fund and are now serving the Lord in their native lands.
